Retailers on the rise

Lower rental rates offer opportunities to move, expand

Consumers aren't the only ones looking for bargains these days. So are the owners of the places where they eat and shop.

Merchants across Greater Baltimore have been gobbling up space vacated by other businesses in the past year as landlords dropped their rental rates to keep their spaces full.

Retailers have leased more than 1 million square feet of new space in just the past six months, shrinking the region's vacancy rate for retail space down from 6.6 percent to 5.8 percent since July, according to statistics from Lutherville's MacKenzie Commercial Real Estate Services LLC.

Some of that was driven by large deals, like wholesaler Costco's lease of nearly 127,000 square feet

Tuition bill stirs work force debate

Business groups at odds over immigration policies

A perennial issue in Annapolis over whether to give children of illegal immigrants in-state tuition rates is stirring debate not only on immigration policy but the bill's impact on the future of the state's work force and economy.

Maryland could become the 12th state to adopt the policy, which would consider the students state residents for tuition purposes provided their parents pay state income taxes. The issue has been a lightning rod for criticism of immigration reform, with many saying it essentially condones illegal immigration.

But some say the more important issue is addressing gaping holes in the state's high-tech work force. Keeping children of immigrants some of the fastest-growing populations in the state - in state schools could help meet that demand for workers, an argument supported by one recent study. The debate could once again come down to immigration policy concerns, and legislative leaders are pre-

Md. nursing homes' cash flow crimped by stalled Medicaid cases

Maryland nursing homes are struggling to keep in the black as they grapple with an influx of Medicaid patients, state budget cuts and increased federal regulations. A backup in Medicaid applications is causing major cash flow problems for these facilities.

The eligibility process — from the time a patient applies for long-term care Medicaid benefits to the point when the state determines whether an individual is eligible — is supposed to take 30 days for the state to

But cases are getting pushed back anywhere from six months up to a year, which means nursing homes aren't getting reimbursed for the services they provide patients in that time period. The result is that nursing homes are writing off expenses as bad debt or they're deciding to dip into their cash reserves or take out new lines of credit just to keep employees on their payrolls and pay for health care services for patients.

The majority of nursing home residents are dually eligible for both Medicare and Medicaid, but Medicare has limited coverage for long-term care stays. A patient must meet a specific medical criteria and at the most, Medicare only covers up to 100 days of a patient's stay. So nursing homes rely on Medicaid reimbursements as a significant portion of their income.

'Most businesses could never operate like this," said Danna Kauffman, senior vice president of LifeSpan Network, which represents senior care providers in the mid-Atlantic.

Kauffman said several factors have come together to create what some see as a crisis for nursing homes.
